



The Jenő Balajthy Scholarship Fund

The **Jenő Balajthy Scholarship Fund** was created by a bequest from Dr. Klara B. Yoe, M.D., in memory of her late father.

The scholarship recipient will be nominated by the University of Richmond Office of Admission according to the criteria described below:

1. The individual is a male or female enrolled or admitted as a full-time undergraduate student.
2. The individual is the child of an ordained minister or elder of the Hungarian Reformed Church.
3. The individual is a competitive secondary school student (with a strong “A” or “B” converted average and SAT-1 combined scores of at least 1200).
4. The individual maintains a minimum grade point average of 3.0 during his or her undergraduate years at the University of Richmond.
